



WHAT IS Yom Teruah?

FEAST OF TRUMPETS

Leviticus 23:23-25

The LORD said to Moses, “Say to the Israelites: ‘On the first day of the seventh month you are to have a day of sabbath rest, a sacred assembly commemorated with trumpet blasts. Do no regular work but present a food offering to the LORD.’”

Coronation Day

It was on this day that Israel would crown their new kings with loud trumpet blasts. In the same way, the true King will be crowned with a trumpet blast at the 2nd coming of Yeshua.

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; 1 Corinthians 15:51-52

Teruah = “alarm, shout, blast”

It is to be a day of blowing and trumpet blasts (Numbers 29:1) to signal the time to get ready for the upcoming Day of Atonement, Yom Kippur, the High Holy Day. The King is coming to judge!

Teshuvah = repent and return!

It signals the start of the 10 Days of Awe, the time between Trumpets and the Day of Atonement, where we examine the motives of our hearts and align ourselves with Yahweh. It is the time to repent, make amends, and ask forgiveness to those we’ve wronged.

Dress Rehearsal

Every year, we have the opportunity to rehearse for the day that we will meet our King face to face! One day, the trumpet will sound, and judgement will be sealed forever. Now is the time to put into practice
The Way of God!
